Nothing in this Call-Off Contract excludes or limits the liability of the Buyer for payment of the Charges (including, but not limited to, termination Charges).

#### **CALL-OFF CHARGES**

Clause 4.7 of Zellis Terms and Conditions embedded in Call Off Schedule 21 (Supplier Funished Terms) shall not apply and instead the following shall apply: Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Call-Off Contract, the Charges will increase annually on each anniversary of 1st November 2022 by the Index. #### **EXIT**

Subject to the below terms, on expiry or termination of this Call-Off Contract, following the Buyer's request, the Supplier will provide to the Buyer one data extract at no cost. The Buyer will request such data extract with a minimum of 6 week's notice.

The data extract will be in the default data format which is an Oracle data pump export. The Oracle standard data export process will be used to extract the entirety of the data in the database into a flat file. The data in this file is not directly readable in this format and must be imported back into a database in order to be useable. The Oracle database would need to be of the same version (or higher) as the existing database.

Any additional data extracts may be provided upon request and at additional cost, to be agreed.

The Buyer will provide the Supplier with all necessary co-operation to enable the Supplier to perform its obligations in relation to this section and all necessary information or access to such information as may be required by the Supplier to provide the Services.

MINIMUM PERIOD OF NOTICE FOR NO\_FAULT TERMINATION AND TERMINATION CHARGE

The Buyer shall have the right to terminate this contract on 90 days prior written notice.

If this Call-off Contract is terminated by the Buyer:

- (i) in accordance with this paragraph; or
- (ii) due to failure to comply with any obligations under any public procurement laws,

the Buyer shall pay the Supplier a termination charge equal to 83% of fees that would have otherwise been payable for the licences and/or Service during the period between the date of such early termination and the Call Off Expiry Date.
