Payment is made per assessment based upon a general average material proportion within assessments, calculated at 40%.

	a) The Latest Index (L) is the latest index as issued by the <i>Client</i> . The L, which is at the discretion of the <i>Client</i> , is based upon the issued consumer price index ((CPI) based upon the 12-month rate) before the date of assessment of an amount due.
	b) The Price Volatility Provision (PVP) at each date of assessment of an amount due is the total of the Material Factor as defined below multiplied by L for the index linked to it.
	c) Material Factor (MF) 40% is used, based on a general average material proportion across our programme. The volatility provision is only associated with material element. No volatility provision is applicable to any other component of costs.

	Through a Compensation Event the Client shall pay the PVP. PVP is calculated as:
	Assessment x MF x L = PVP
Z30.3	Price Increase
	Each time the amount due is assessed, an amount for price increase is added to the total of the Prices which is the change in the Price for Work Done to Date for the materials component only (and the corresponding proportion) since the last assessment of the amount due multiplied PVP for the date of the current assessment.
Z30.4	Compensation Events
	The Contractor shall submit a compensation event for the PVP on a monthly basis (where applicable) capturing Defined Cost only for the PWDD increase in month. Forecasted costs should only be considered for the June 2022 period compensation event.

Entries in the first four columns in this Price List are made either by the Client or the tenderer.







The *Contractor* shows on each programme which they submit for acceptance (in form of Gantt chart showing the critical path, proposed order and timing to undertake the *works* and proposed plant and labour resources) the following:

- (a) Period required for mobilisation/ planning & post contract award
- (b) starting date
- (c) Each of the activities listed within the Price List
- (d) Any key third party interfaces: lead in periods for materials and sub-contractors; time required to obtain consents/waste permits; stated constraints; *Contractor's* risks.
- (e) Completion date

The *Contractor* shall be required to submit on a weekly basis (or as otherwise agreed at the precommencement meeting) daily site records.

The programme shall be updated and submitted to the *Client* on a monthly basis to support each payment application to confirm work complete to that assessment date. Any EWN or CE that impacts on the completion date shall be supported by an updated programme.

Un-scoped or additional projects shall be added to the package upon acceptance of the relevant CE's and revised programmes.
