APPENDIX A

Littlemore Parish Council collaborated with a group of local parents and carers who use the park. The following is a list of specific suggestions received:

- 1. New play equipment offering variations in height, challenge, interaction and excitement and offering a range of play appeal including imaginative play (for example a pirate ship, rocket or other themed play).
- 2. Equipment suitable for a wide range of needs and age including SEND, physical disability and for nearly walkers/toddlers up to the age of 12 years. Ideally, this equipment will be zoned by age to provide a segregated (though not fenced off) toddler area.
- 3. Additional sociable seating/picnic benches which might have with a particular appeal to teenage girls.
- 4. Specific play equipment mentioned by residents in response to our survey include:
 - a. Swings
 - b. Zip wire
 - c. Table tennis
 - d. Monkey bars
 - e. Climbing apparatus
 - f. Slides
 - g. Roundabout
 - h. Springy toys
 - i. Sensory equipment.
- 5. Safety flooring that it is both age and equipment appropriate, as well as hardwearing and easy to maintain. Our preference would be for bonded rubber.
- 6. Our preference is for steel structures as our timber play equipment has deteriorated with age.
- 7. Consideration of vandalism resistant equipment where possible.
- 8. Landscaping sympathetic to and in keeping with surrounding areas and play equipment, including consideration of safety.
- 9. A comprehensive maintenance schedule for all new equipment installed.
