

**NOTE ON GRASS AREAS**

Generally existing grass areas should be retained wherever possible. Where existing grassland must be removed, due to earthworks etc, the areas should be re-seeded in accordance with the detailed planting proposals.  
Sports pitches are to be newly created and seeded with an appropriate high wear tolerance amenity grass seed mix recommended for use on football pitches e.g. DLF Trifolium Pitch mix, sown in accordance with suppliers recommendations, or similar. Note pitches must not be used until grass is fully established.
