This Schedule sets out the characteristics of the Deliverables that the Supplier will be required to make to the Buyers under this Call-Off Contract


In order to realise the aims of this project, the following requirements are to be fulfilled:

Identify the existing Operating Model (OM) of Operations Division

1. A full analysis of the current 'as-is' state of Operations Division including:



- b. Acceptance and/or challenge of the pre-provided OM constraints,
- c. An understanding of priority implementation areas,
- d. Alignment with the strategic ambitions of the 1 Ops initiative and the culture it is aiming to create.
- 2. Evaluate the current state against similar organisations and best practise. Provide case studies demonstrating TOM's implemented in similar organisations along with the associated benefits/dis-benefits.
- 3. Provide and present key opportunities for change to the current OM that take into account what has been identified in point 1 of the requirements. This should be presented to senior stakeholders for initial feedback/quidance.



6. Submit weekly progress updates, and attend fortnightly progress meetings.



There may be a potential requirement for follow on work, depending on the outcomes from the deliverables, to support the first phase of the implementation of a finalised TOM, following sign off from senior stakeholders.
