THIS AGREEMENT is made the 7th day of March 2025 PARTIES:

- 1. **Ministry of Defence** acting as part of the Crown (the "*Client*"); and
- Tetra Tech Limited which is a company incorporated in and in accordance with the laws of England & Wales (Company No. 01959704 whose registered office address is at 3 Sovereign Square, Sovereign Street, Leeds, West Yorkshire, LS1 4ER (the "Consultant").




