- Technology Errors and Omissions Insurance. Technology errors and omissions insurance coverage in the amount of ten million dollars (US\$10,000,000), including cyber security liability, network security and privacy. Additionally, JAGGAER maintains an excess technology errors and omissions insurance coverage in the amount of five million dollars (US \$5,000,000).
- Automobile Liability Insurance. Automobile liability insurance covering all owned, hired or non-owned motor vehicles used in conjunction with the performance of this Agreement in the amount of million dollars per occurrence (US\$1,000,000), combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage.
- Workers' Compensation Insurance. Worker's compensation insurance with statutory limits as applicable, and employer's liability insurance in the amount of five hundred thousand dollars (US\$500,000) per accident for bodily injury by accident and five hundred thousand dollars (US\$500,000) per employee for bodily injury by disease with a five hundred thousand dollars (US\$500,000) policy limit for bodily injury by disease. This shall cover all JAGGAER employees who are engaged in any work performed under this Agreement.
- **Umbrella Coverage.** Umbrella Coverage in the amount of five million dollars (US\$5,000,000) aggregate and five million dollars (US\$5,000,000) per occurrence over general liability, auto liability and employer's liability.
