

Introduction

This year, Lambeth Council launched the second edition of <u>Your Street Your Way Design</u> <u>Competition</u>, where the public were invited to submit their ideas to redesign various locations across the borough. One of these locations is Chestnut Road and the <u>winning design</u> is a mural (image below).

We are now looking for a muralist or collective to work alongside Lambeth Council and the location winner to adapt and realise the winning design.

The colourful mural representing is an illustration of The Great North Wood that was once an ancient woodland that stretched across South London.

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Section 3 Description

Background and rationale

Your Streets Your Way is a street design competition which gives the public the opportunity to redesign local locations to make them more attractive to spend time and walk, wheel and cycle through. All of the locations in the competition are in the Low Traffic Neighbourhood areas and have been strategically chosen or through feedback from residents. Lambeth is seeking an experienced muralist or collective who can work to a tight deadline to realise the mural by Autumn 2023.

Commission purpose

This commission is part of the Your Street Your Way Design Competition Project: <u>https://www.your-streets-your-way.xyz/.</u> Please also see attached pack for more details on the winning design.

The mural will be used to:

- beautify and brightening the space
- celebrate the history of the area

Key considerations

The commissioned artist will be expected to:

- Meet with the winning designer to discuss any potential adaptions that will ensure the mural is suitable for painting (We suggest up to three meetings). The commissioned artist will create design iterations to be signed off by Lambeth Council. Although the design is subject to adaption, the final design must reflect the location winner's original design.
- Prime/prepare the substrate (parapet metal, brick walls etc.) prior to the design being painted.
- Use paints which are long-lasting and appropriate for the surfaces.
- Provide a colour palette to Lambeth council for any further touch ups or issues in the future.
- Demonstrate the installations longevity and either no, or very low, maintenance costs.

- Consider how best to deter or hide the inevitable tagging and graffiti that will take place. The finished design should then be coated in permanent anti-graffiti varnish.
- Complete the work in a short space of time to avoid disruption to the residents and business (Aspire Wellbeing Centre)
- Provide your own insurance to cover yourself and others while undertaking the work.
- Provide any equipment or equipment for working at height (if necessary).
- Provide a timeline and risk assessment when commissioned.

In submitting a proposal, the artist/collective is agreeing that the Council shall own all artwork, drafts, reproductions etc and all other intellectual property produced by the collective under this Contract and shall own all publication rights. The artist/designer shall indemnify the Council against all costs and damages associated with infringements of intellectual property rights in relation to the Services provided by the Artist.

Lambeth Council will be responsible for:

- Final sign off of designs
- Seeking all necessary licences and permissions for the installation.

Your submission

The competition is open to any collective or group of artists with a track record of delivering street artwork of comparable scale in the public realm.

Assessing bids and awarding criteria

Tenders will be assessed 30% on price and 70% on quality. The lowest priced bid will score the maximum 30 points with others benchmarked against it, calculated as below:

Lowest priced bid Your bid x30 = your price score

Pricing should be broken down on a borough-by-borough basis, reflecting the different numbers of businesses that would have to be surveyed within each one, and making it easy to determine the price should the borough wish to commission only specific elements of proposal. Tenders should break down the estimated time each member of staff will spend on the commission along with their hourly rate.

The quality evaluation criteria will consider:

BUDGET

A specific budget value is not set for this commission. Bidders should balance the resourcing and materials to do the job well with a competitive price. The total fee must cover all costs needed to complete the mural, including design adaptation, installation, and construction, materials and any equipment hire/insurance and design fees.

STAFF AND CUSTOMER SERVICE

The Authority requires the Potential Provider to provide a sufficient level of resource throughout the duration of the contract to consistently deliver a quality service.

Potential Provider's staff assigned to the contract shall have the relevant qualifications and experience to deliver the Contract.

The Potential Provider shall ensure that staff understand the Authority's vision and objectives and will provide excellent customer service to the Authority throughout the duration of the Contract.
