### **Contract Execution**

- Was incurred due to a breach of safety requirements, or due additional work to comply with safety requirements

### **Z8** Requirement for Invoice

If a certified payment is late, or if a payment is late because the *Service Manager* has not issued a certificate which should be issued, interest is paid on the late payment. Interest is assessed from the date by which the late payment should have been made until the date when the late payment is made, and is included in the first assessment after the late payment is made.


