

SCHEDULE 4

Standards

1 GENERAL

- 1.1 Throughout the term of this Contract, the Parties shall monitor and notify each other of any new or emergent standards which could affect the Service Provider's provision, or the Authority's receipt, of the Services. Any changes to the Standards, including the adoption of any such new or emergent standard, shall be agreed in accordance with the Change Control Procedure.
- 1.2 Where Standards referenced conflict with each other, then the Authority shall advise the Service Provider on which Standard it shall adopt. Any such alteration to any Standard(s) shall require the prior written agreement of the Authority and shall be implemented within an agreed timescale.

2 STANDARDS

- 2.1 The Service Provider shall comply with the Standards set out at Annex 1.
