1 Instructions to Tenderers

1.1 Introduction

Persons proposing to submit a tender are advised first to read the Contract Notice and the contents of this document carefully to ensure that they are fully familiar with the nature and extent of the obligations to be accepted by them if their Tender is accepted.

The 'Instructions to Tenderers' (this Section 1) do not form part of any Contract.

Failure to comply with these instructions may lead to tenders being rejected. Tenderers should seek to clarify any points of doubt or difficulty before submitting a Tender. For this purpose contact should be made with Steven Best on 0113 245 0006.

1.2 Tender rules

1.2.1 Collusive Tendering

Any Tenderer who:-

- fixes or adjusts the amount of his Tender by or under or in accordance with any agreement or arrangement with any persons; or
- communicates to any person other than the Employer the amount or approximate amount of the proposed Tender except where the disclosure is made in confidence in order to obtain quotations for insurance necessary for the preparation of the Tender; or
- enters into any agreement with any person that he shall refrain from tendering or as to the
 amount of any Tender to be submitted; or offers or agrees to pay or give, or does pay or
 gives, any sum of money, inducement or valuable consideration directly or indirectly to any
 person for doing or having done or causing or having caused to be done in relation to any
 other Tender or proposed Tender for the services, any act or omission,

shall (without prejudice to any other civil remedies and without prejudice to any criminal liability which such conduct by a Contractor may attract) be disqualified.

1.2.2 Guarantees of Contract

If the Contractor is a subsidiary Company within the meaning of Section 736 of the Companies Act 1985 it shall also provide a guarantee by its holding company or companies (as defined by the said Section 736) to secure the due performance by the Contractor of its obligations.

1.2.3 Period of Validity

Tenderers are required to keep tenders valid for acceptance for a period of 60 days from the closing date of receipt of tenders.

1.2.4 Site Visits

The site locations are publically accessible. Tenderers will be deemed to have inspected the site before submitting their tender. Accompanied site visits can be arranged if required.

1.3 Tender submission

The Tender will be awarded under the NEC3 Engineering and Construction Short Contract (ECSC) form of contract. The formal tender offer shall therefore be made by completing the Contractor's Offer section of the Contract Data within the NEC3 ECSC document provided in Appendix A.

The Contractor shall provide the following documents with their Tender:

- Contractor's Offer
- Completed Price List
- Completed Health & Safety Questionnaire
- Outline Programme
- Outline Method Statement
- Examples of similar previous work
- Details of proposed sub-contractors, if any
- Insurance details confirming that the Contract requirements are met

Tenderers shall treat all tender documents as private and confidential. No alterations or additions may be made to the Contract Data or any other of the Contract Documents.

The tender must be submitted via the Contracts Finder portal:

Tenders are to be submitted no later than 12:00hrs (midday) on Monday 19th August 2019.

1.4 Price List

The price list is provided with key elements pre-populated with quantities. This is to allow for a more transparent 'like-for-like' comparison of tender price submissions. Contractors are requested to price against the items listed and also add any additional items they consider necessary to fulfil the brief.

1.5 Tender evaluation and award

Tenders will be assessed on the basis of both quality and price. The contract will be awarded to the Tenderer submitting the most economically advantageous offer assessed on the basis of quality and price proposals.

Sustrans Ltd does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any Tender.

The amount of the successful Tender and the name of the Contractor may be published on the Contracts Finder portal. If in special circumstances a Tenderer does not wish details of his Tender, if successful, to be released he should notify his objections and reasons at time of tendering.

1.6 Clarifications

Should there be any doubt or obscurity as to the meaning of the tender documents, or as to anything to be done under the Contract, or as to any other matter concerning the Contract, the Tenderer must contact the Employer. Requests for clarification can be submitted via the Contracts Finder portal or in writing by email to:

The formal tender offer shall be made by completing the Contractor's Offer section of the Contract Data.

The Tenderer is required to enter prices against the Price List section of the Contract Data.

2.4 Contractor Health and Safety Questionnaire

The Tenderer is required to complete the Contractor Health and Safety Questionnaire included in Appendix B.

This will be used to help assess the competence and health and safety arrangements of tenderers and will go towards the quality element of the tender evaluation.
