This notice is not a call for competition - The Coal Authority intends to issue the call for competition on or after 29 April 2019

The Coal Authority was established by Parliament to undertake specific statutory duties, set out in the Coal Industry Act 1994, associated with licensing coal mining operations; managing property and the historic legacy arising from the ownership of the coal reserves and underground workings; settling subsidence damage claims not falling on coal mine operators and providing access to coal mining information.

Deliverables from this contract is to build a new cascade, diversion of services and possible modifications to the existing inlet structure **for an existing mine water treatment scheme in South Yorkshire, Near Penistone.** The Contractor is expected to construct the *works* as per the Detailed Designs.

Anticipated time lines will be for issue of tender **May 2019** and for all works to be complete **October 2019.**
