A.1 Scope of Requirement

A.1.a The RAF are spear-heading a horizon scanning effort as the 'Horizons Group' as part of a whole force concept to truly bring a tested academic approach to how the British Military conducts futures work. The Defence Force Development model is a key product that provides a constructive challenge to how the RAF and wider MOD scan the distant horizon. Under the direction of the Chief of the Air Staff, the Futures Group are constantly reviewing how best to produce quality outputs with limited resource. The RAF has a lot of valuable staff that are experts and need the right tools to harness their knowledge.

The futures team's most vital asset is their time: time to think, contemplate, imagine, and discuss. The use of Natural Language Processing (NLP) techniques and existing Open Source Intelligence (OSINT) data sources will aid in discovering, organising, and presenting useful insights that save the Human Machine Team (HMT) time and consequently should result in better forecasting.
