The Highways Agency's existing winter ICT services expire in 2015. The Agency is considering how best to enable the successful delivery of a number of integrated weather and winter service related information services to replace the suite of existing services. Core ICT services include weather information, winter reporting and winter fleet data logging.

The Highways Agency wishes to carry out market engagement to engage with suppliers,

test assumptions and establish the optimal approach and contracting terms to deliver best value and achieve the commercial aims of this procurement. An industry event will be held at Conference Aston, Aston University, Aston Triangle, Birmingham, B4 7ET on Friday 4th July 2014. Currently, we expect to hold two presentation sessions between 10:30 & 12:30 and 13:30 & 15:30 respectively.
