



Display Objects for Saxon Warriors and the Prittlewell Prince Exhibition







Notes on object dimensions: All measurements are in millimetres and are as accurate as possible.







Spearheads / Knives & Sword fragments: width was measured in 2 places; the narrowest (**w:a**) and widest (**w:b**) points of the object. The narrowest point being the tip of the blade or around the shaft (wherever was narrowest) and the widest point was taken across the blade. Height was measured with the object laid flat and the height taken from the tallest point from the flat surface.






Bone combs: due to the fragility of the objects, these were measured in their packaging and therefore the fragments were treated as one piece and measured as such.




