1	Why is Competitive Dialogue Used?	The NMRN recognises that the timber requirements are potentially demanding and complex, and must be discussed with industry to develop the requirements and an overall solution. The purpose of the competitive dialogue process is to progressively develop a solution with participants that best meets the NMRN's requirements due to the technical, legal and financial complexity of the Programme.
2	What response is needed to the Guidance Document, and there is also a tender published for timber supply.	<p>The Guidance Document for the Competitive Dialogue Process for the Supply of Timber for HMS Victory Conservation is guidance on the process to be used.
