

Call-Off Schedule 5 (Pricing Details)

1. Indexation

- 1.1. The Call-Off Contract Prices will be fixed until the first anniversary of the contract. After this, this Call-Off Contract can only be adjusted for pricing on each following extension year start date (the date of anniversary of the Contract Start Date which is the "Review Date").
- 1.2. The maximum increase will be determined by multiplying the relevant amount or sum by the percentage increase of two per cent (2%).
- 1.3. The Supplier shall give Buyer at least three (3) Months' notice in writing prior to a Review Date (the next possible extension period) where it wants to request an increase. If the Supplier does not give notice in time, then it will only be able to request an increase prior to the next Review Date (the next possible extension period).
- 1.4. Any notice requesting an increase shall include:
 - 1.4.1. a list of the Call-Off contract Prices to be reviewed;
 - 1.4.2. for each Call-Off contract Price under review, written evidence of the justification for the requested increase including:
 - 1.4.3. a breakdown of the profit and cost components that comprise the relevant Call-Off contract Price;
 - 1.4.4. details of the movement in the different identified cost components of the relevant Call-Off contract Price;
 - 1.4.5. reasons for the movement in the different identified cost components of the relevant Call-Off contract Price;
 - 1.4.6. evidence that the Supplier has attempted to mitigate against the increase in the relevant cost components; and
 - 1.4.7. evidence that the Supplier's profit component of the relevant Call-Off contract Price is no greater than that applying to Call-Off contract Prices using the same pricing mechanism as at the Contract Start Date.
