### **Background**

The Authority has requested to extend the Term of the Agreement for a period of up to 6 months from the current expiry date of 31 January 2023. This extension is intended to protect the Services and ensure a smooth exit from the IMS3 services under the Agreement and transition to the new services provider.

#### **Description of change:**

In accordance with paragraph 11.3 of CCN0053 ("Extension of Term of the IMS3 Agreement and other related amendments") the Parties agree to extend the Further Extended Term for a period of 6

(six) months, with the option to extend for an additional 3months, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Clause 52 (Termination Rights).

#### **Changes to the Agreement**

The Agreement, including any previous CCNs, shall remain effective and unaltered except as amended by this CCN. Any capitalised terms in this CCN shall have the same meaning given in the Agreement, unless the context requires otherwise or unless otherwise defined in this CCN. The Contractor and the Authority acknowledge that this CCN shall, once signed by both Parties, constitute a binding variation to the Agreement.

#### **Definitions**

The definition introduced in CCN0053 of the "Further Extended Term" shall be amended as follows: "the period of 42 (forty-two) months commencing on the expiry of the Extended Term, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Clause 52 (Termination Rights);"

The below table shows the Extension options exercised by the Authority so far.

#### Option to further extend

Paragraph 11.3 of CCN0053 to be amended as follows: "The Authority shall have the option to extend the Further Extended Term by a further 3 months. If the Authority intends to exercise this option, it must give written notice to such effect to the Contractor no later than 30<sup>th</sup> Apr 2023."

#### **Financial Model Update**

As part of this CCN075 there is a requirement to revise the SL6- Server Hosting Variable unit charge as set out in Clause 5.4 of Schedule 9.1 of the Agreement. This revision is as a direct impact of the Contractors Data Centre Energy cost increases.

The tables below detail the current to the revised change in Unit price:

#### **DHSC Agreed Cost Reduction Credit**
