


Latest profile information – 26 October 2018

58.9% of Derby's looked after children and young people are male, with **39.4%** being 10 to 15 years of age

530 children are currently looked after in Derby, **88.8 per 10,000 population**

71.5% of children looked after are in Foster Care placements, with **70.4%** of these placed in IFA's

33.6% of children and young people have been looked after for less than a year, whilst **23.8%** have been looked after for 5 years or more



The largest percentage of children and young people are 'White-British' (**59.4%**) followed by Dual Heritage (**14.3%**)

72.1% of Derby's children in care are looked after due to 'abuse or neglect'

61.3% of Derby's looked after children are placed outside of the City

18.1% of Derby's looked after children are accommodated under Section 20, **55.5%** have a full care order and **17.2%** have an interim care order
