1. Summary Programme Information

Provision of a Primary Care Leadership Development Programme, delivered via a series of virtual workshops. This programme will support current and aspiring leaders from diverse roles across the health systems in the East of England region, enhancing participants' ability to step forward and behave and lead differently from whatever role they are in, including understanding the new context of care and developing the ability to work collaboratively and compassionately with others. It will enhance personal effectiveness and capacity to make a difference locally. The key objectives of the programme are to:

- Develop and enhance leadership skills and strategic thinking
- Extend participants' understanding of how to engage others to deliver change
- Understand the principles of systems change and how to apply these to local challenges
- Enhance and develop participants' personal network of healthcare leaders and decision makers in Primary care

The programme is delivered over a series of 5 virtual workshops, with up to 25 participants per cohort. The programme structure also includes virtual Support Surgeries and Reflection Sessions, as well as the provision of a participant toolkit.
