Table 1

Parachutes identified in the Equipment List encompass all sub-assemblies and other equipment. Eg pack, harness, canopy, pilot chutes, drogue chutes, deployment bags (including for Dakota aircraft), static lines, dashpots, risers, sliders etc.

Cypres is an acronym for Cybernetic Parachute Release System. It is an Automatic Activation Device (AAD) which requires 4-yearly and 8-yearly maintenance checks.

USA HOLDINGS

1. The following indicates the quantity of parachutes to be stored and number of maintenance events to be undertaken at the West Coast USA facility. These figures are indicative and variable and encompassed within the demand forecast at Annex B.

Maintained & stored by Contractor:

- 200 x BT80 corresponding to 2,200 packs in 11 pulses of approximately 200 per month (+3000 military packs)
- 180 x BT380 corresponding to 1600 packs broadly 150 per month (+400 military packs)
- 50 x LPS corresponding to 800 packs broadly 50/100 per month (+3000 military packs)
