

Tender Evaluation Criteria

This tender will be evaluated using the MEAT method. This is a comparative score and the scoring method is worked out using the rationale below. The optimum is the highest technical score and the lowest price, this together together would get the highest total score. If you had the highest technical score but your price was double that of the lowest priced compliant tender then this would receive a lower total score.

Price will attract 60% and the technical will attract 40%.

Price will be $60 \times (\text{lowest priced technically compliant bid divided by tender price})$

Technical will be $40 \times (\text{tender technical mark divided by highest technical mark})$

The scoring will be as per the Requirement of Response.
