The contract to be awarded involves cost consultancy and quantity surveying services for a new day centre for Adults with Learning Disabilities. The start and end dates of this requirement are 1st October 2015 to 31st October 2017 and it will be reviewed on an annual basis. The estimated aggregated value of this contract is up to £100,000. The contract will be let for a period of 2 years.

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All interested suppliers must successfully complete the Lambeth Business Questionnaire online. If you have questions, ask the procurement officer in charge of the tendering exercise.

This will be a two stage tender process with the Business Questionnaire and Invitation to Tender responses evaluated at the same time to produce a shortlist. Shortlisted candidates will then be invited to interview. We plan to send out invitations to interview shortlisted suppliers on or after 28th August with the intention to commence the contract on 1st October. Tender selection will be based upon a price plus quality evaluation methodology as set out in the ITT.
