Section 6

Selection Criteria

- 1. The tender process will be conducted to ensure that tenders are evaluated fairly to ascertain the tender that represents best value to BFTC.
- 2. Account will be taken of any factors which impact on the tenderer's suitability that emerge from the tendering process and relate to information supplied by the tenderer.
- 3. Your response to our requirements will be evaluated under the following headings/weighting:

1.	Quality	30%
2.	Professional Capability	20%
3.	Health & Safety	20%
4.	Environmental Issues	20%
5.	Price	10%

- 4. BFTC will produce a short-list from the tenders received and may invite a presentation from each organisation short-listed and visit the premises of each one. BFTC may wish to visit a representative site where a similar service is already being provided and/or seek references from candidates' previous clients and projects.
- 5. This short-list from the tenders received, and the designs from this shortlist (with all identification marks being covered/removed) will be presented to the residents of Badbury Heights through a public consultation. The plans will be on the BFTC website and in the office, with a Surveymonkey link for people to respond to. A newsletter will also be distributed.
- 6. The final contract will be awarded to the highest scoring tender candidate as indicated in no.3 alongside consideration of the public choice of design.
