



Hall and other room floor areas – square meterage for understanding scale of required cleaning footprint.

(All quoted square metres are approximate due to irregular shapes of different areas/rooms)

Please note these areas are included as part of the 4 week 'hall cycle' of cyclical cleaning. Anything listed here is considered part of each respective hall. I.e. The 'Retail shop' is considered part of Hall One.

Hall 1 – 1181 m2 - all public display area's where the aircraft are displayed, and: -

- Welcome area 198 m2.
- 1st floor gallery (vinyl floor, timber) 154.6 m2.
- Ramp to ground floor 53 m2.
- Retail shop 225.0 m2.

Hall 2 - 2542 m2 - all public display area's where the aircraft are displayed and: -

• All mezzanine galleries (Battle of the Atlantic, WRNS, Operation Skua and the bridge).

Hall 3 – 1932 m2 – Flight deck area where the aircraft are displayed only, and: -

- Island tour The various compartment floor areas that need cleaning come to an additional 784 m2.
- (This includes Power 1, Power2 and the goofer's deck).

Hall 4 – 2176 m2 - the floor of hangar only where the aircraft are displayed.
