Short description of requirement: In order to meet the objectives of a developing Navy Platform the requirement for the provision of Intelligence Coordination and Analysis Services has been identified. Coordination Services

- a. Intelligence tasking and coordination of all investigations and assessments.
- b. Coordinate the process management of investigative/analytical output.
- c. Coordinate options with Intelligence stakeholders.
- d. Conduct option centric Intelligence led Investigations into complex and sensitive State Based Threats.
- e. Understand and be able to exploit current Search, Visualisation and Analytical techniques.
- f. Assist with development and training of new investigative capabilities within the team and where possible realise benefit for broader Defence.
- g. Introduce Intelligence focused concepts and capabilities, providing specialist intelligence advice to military Staff within the team.

Analysis Services

a. Ensure option development is supported by analytical effort that by provides written and briefing outputs as required.

- b. Collate and manage intelligence material in additional with security guidance and project requirements.
- c. Conduct option centric intelligence led investigations into complex and sensitive State based threats.
- d. Manage the common intelligence data derived picture through close liaison with the Data science Team located within the project.
- e. Liaise at desk level and with Navy Intelligence Analytical Teams.
- f. Project management of options that is derived from data and intelligence information.
