1. Yes, it is acceptable for the Project Specific Questions to Assess Technical and Professional Ability on page 53 to be included within the research proposal, providing they are clearly identified.
2. Do you envisage that particular sectors within CITB remit would be more relevant to the research or do you want the sample to be broadly representative of CITB sub-sectors?

We envisage the sample to be representative of CITB's remit.

3. Are you interested in the perspectives of young people who have considered or undertaken some construction training or employment and who have been unemployed, or are you more broadly interested in the experiences of a range of young people who are NEET / unemployed regardless of their prior interest or engagement with the construction industry?

We would prefer those who have previously undertaken construction training/employment, although we fully appreciate this narrows the scope, for a "hard to reach" audience and would not be adverse to samples also including young people without prior interest/engagement with construction.
