RUSSIAN/BELARUSSIAN PRODUCTS AND/OR SERVICES

- 1.1 The Supplier shall, and shall procure that their Sub-contractors shall, notify the Buyer in writing as soon as they become aware that:
- 1.2 a. the Supplier Deliverables and/or Services contain any Russian/Belarussian products and/or services; or
- b. that the Supplier or any part of the Supplier's supply chain is linked to entities who are constituted or organised under the law of Russia or Belarus, or under the control (full or partial) of a Russian/Belarusian person or entity. Please note that this does not include companies:
 - (1) registered in the UK or in a country with which the UK has a relevant international agreement providing reciprocal rights of access in the relevant field of public procurement; and/or
 - (2) which have significant business operations in the UK or in a country with which the UK has a relevant international agreement providing reciprocal rights of access in the relevant field of public procurement.
- 1.4 The Supplier shall, and shall procure that their Sub-contractors shall, include in such notification (or as soon as reasonably practicable following the notification) full details of the Russian products, services and/or entities and shall provide all reasonable assistance to the Authority to understand the nature, scope and impact of any such products, services and/or entities on the provision of the Contract Deliverables and/or Services.
- 1.5 The Buyer shall consider the notification and information provided by the Supplier and advise the Supplier in writing of any concerns the Buyer may have and/or any action which the Buyer will require the Supplier to take. The Supplier shall be required to submit a response to the concerns raised by the Buyer, including any plans to mitigate those concerns, within 14 business days of receipt of the Buyer's written concerns, for the Buyer's consideration.
- 1.6 The Supplier shall include provisions equivalent to those set out in this clause in all relevant Sub-contracts.
