

INSTALLATION GUIDELINES *(These are guidelines only, and do not replace advice from qualified professionals)*

- Root-fix – 500x325x500mm excavation per post, approx. 600mm in the ground, backfilled to 50mm below ground level with standard postcrete, trowelled away for water runoff
- Bolt down – Use epoxy-fixed M12 (or similar) zinc plated anchor bolts 600mm in the ground, backfilled to 50mm below ground level with standard postcrete, trowelled away for water runoff.
