Job Background

As part of the 66kV network there is a requirement to complete 10 year maintenance on the transformers.

T67 & T68 are 66/11KV, 20/35MVA, OFAF (Oil Forced, Air Forced) Cooling System.

Scope

Delivery of services including project , mobilisation, supply of labour, equipment/tools/materials, project management including Health & Safety requirements for the cleaning, preparation and application of a triple coat paint system to the following –

- Transformer Main Tank (including end box)
- Conservator and associated pipework with the transformer
- Oil cooling radiators with the transformer
- kiosk repair/replace housing
- Price to include for scaffolding/tarpaulin tent to cover transformer pen to be supplied.

 Consideration to be made for each kiosk housing – to be reviewed on site visit and confirmed in your quotation if the housings need to be replaced

Cost associated should include for -

- 1. Supply of Environment, Health & Safety documents to ensure safe working on site.
- 2. Creation and supply of QA documentation.
- 3. Mobilisation of a works supervisor and engineering personnel/painters to complete necessary site inductions.
- 4. Wash down pipework area with high pressure washer (do we supply the water?).
- 5. Removal of minor corrosion or defective paintwork by mechanical means.
- 6. Apply full primer coat of paint.
- 7. Apply full top coat of anti-tracking paint with thickness test.
- 8. Final inspection and completion of QA documents
- 9. Complete final cleaning, housekeeping and inspection of work site.
- 10. Personnel demobilise from site.
- 11. Final handover of documentation following acceptance of work com

Work must be completed within a project programme on site (time to be confirmed).

Transformer will be offline/isolated to allow for uninterrupted access throughout.


