To reach the Community Centre

The Community Centre is based at Thorpe Astley and has close access from the M1 Junction 21, and is accessed via the northbound A563 Lubbesthorpe Way, leaving the exit for Thorpe Astley and following the directions for Thorpe Astley South. From Leicester north join the A563 southbound Braunstone Way and leave the junction giving directions for Thorpe Astley South. Continue along Meridian Way and take the second exit onto Murby Way at Thorpe Astley.
