Date: The changes shall take effect from 1 September 2021

1. Description of change:

The NHS Innovation Service will launch in September 2021. This future licence is to set up a new Needs Assessment Service (NAS) that will assess the adoption readiness and specific support requirements of an individual innovation and its innovator. The team will then signpost to the most appropriate support organisation(s). This includes providing a brief summary of the needs assessment for use by support organisations. The assessment may include a process to help the innovator complete gaps in their initial submission.

2. Reason for change:

The Needs Assessment Service will add value by giving a first review of all submitted innovations to normalise data quality and suggest which organisations are best placed to support. A rapid, expert-led needs assessment is done once, centrally, as opposed to every organisation separately reviewing submission of variable quality and relevance to them. Innovators receive prompt feedback and can

course-correct, improving the quality of the innovation pipeline for patients and the wider health system. Once the initial needs assessment of an innovation is complete, support organisations can continue to self-organise, working transparently and passing innovations between themselves, with the Needs Assessment Service acting as a safety net for innovations with no engaging support organisations. This creates efficiencies for all users and allows innovators to take the right steps faster, to accelerate quality products into the hands of patients and NHS staff. It will also provide efficiencies for support organisations who will be able organise their workflow and minimise duplicated work with other organisations

3. Effect on contract price: Contract price will increase by £240,000.
