#### The service is

The overall aim of the *service* is for the *Consultant* to complete Real-Time Flood Forecasting Model Development Guidance (RTMDG) Stage 1 inception tasks for all models and risk locations in the Upper Colne, Lower Colne and Kennet subbasins.

Based on these findings, the *Consultant* shall collaborate with the *Client* to make a "Go/No-Go" decision on whether Stage 2 and Stage 3 modelling tasks (as outlined in a technical programme of works to be produced for each sub-basin) should proceed in a future delivery stage project, or if there is a requirement for a data improvement phase (underpinned by an accepted data improvement plan to be produced for each sub-basin).

The Consultant shall follow the logical process outlined in the Inland Forecast Model Improvements Programme Technical Scopes "Upper Colne", "Lower Colne" and "Kennet" and deliver these modelling and modelling related activities to the standards specified therein accordingly.

#### **Z2** Prevention

The text of clause 18 Prevention is deleted.

Delete the text of clause 60.1(12) and replace with:

The service is affected by any of the following events

- · War, civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power;
- Strikes, riots and civil commotion not confined to the employees of the Consultant and sub consultants.
- lonising radiation or radioactive contamination from nuclear fuel or nuclear waste resulting from the combustion of nuclear fuel.
- · Radioactive, toxic, explosive or other hazardous properties of an explosive nuclear device,
- · Natural disaster.
- · Fire and explosion,
- Impact by aircraft or other aerial device or thing dropped from them.

#### Z3 Disallowed Costs Option C & E contracts only

(including compensation events with the sub contractor, i.e. payment for work that should not have been undertaken). Add the following additional bullets after 'and the cost of ':

- Mistakes or delays caused by the Consultant's failure to follow standards in Scopes/quality plans.
- · Reorganisation of the Consultant's project team.
- Additional costs or delays incurred due to Consultant's failure to comply with published and known guidance or document formats.
- · Exceeding the Scope without prior instruction that leads to abortive cost
- Re-working of documents due to inadequate QA prior to submission, i.e. grammatical, factual arithmetical or design errors.
- Production or preparation of self-promotional material.
- Excessive charges for project management time on a commission for secondments or full time appointments (greater than 5% of commission value)
- · Any hours exceeding 8 per day unless with prior written agreement of the Service Manager
- Any hours for travel beyond the location of the nearest consultant office to the project unless previously agreed with the Service Manager
- Attendance of additional individuals to meetings/ workshops etc who have not been previously invited by the Service Manager
- Costs associated with the attendance at additional meetings after programmed completion, if delay is due to Consultant performance.
- · Costs associated with rectifications that are due to Consultant error or omission.
- Costs associated with the identification of opportunities to improve our processes and procedures for project delivery through the Consultant's involvement
- · Was incurred due to a breach of safety requirements, or due additional work to comply with safety requirements
- · Was incurred as a result of the Client issuing a Yellow or Red Card to prepare a Performance Improvement Plan
- Was incurred as a resulting of rectifying a non-compliance with the Framework Agreement and/or any call off contracts following an audit

#### **Z6 The Schedule of Cost Components**

Amend Clause 11.2 (17)

Defined Cost is the cost of the components in the Short Schedule of Cost Components as amended in the Framework Schedule 2 less Disallowed Cost.

Add clause 11.2 (19)

The People Rates are the people rates unless later changed in accordance with the contract.

#### **Z24 Requirement for Invoice**

Add the following sentence to the end of clause 51.1:

The Party to which payment is due submits an invoice to the other Party for the amount to be paid within one week of the Service Manager's Assessment..

Delete existing clause 51.2 and replace with:

51.2 Each certified payment is made within one week after the paying Party receives an invoice from the other Party and If a certified payment is late, interest is paid on the late payment. Interest is assessed from the date by which the late payment should have been made until the date when the late payment is made, and is included in the first assessment after the late payment is made.

#### Z125 Limitation of Liability

Under clause 87.1 after the fourth bullet point insert the additional bullet points:

- loss of or damage to the *Client's* property, to the sum that the *Consultant* is required to insure under the contract in respect of such loss or damage,
- death of or bodily injury to employees of the *Consultant* arising out of and in the course of their employment in connection with the contract, to the sum that the *Consultant* is required to insure under the contract in respect of such death or bodily injury.

#### Z 130 Rate adjustment

Z130.1 The outstanding portion of Defined Cost for People Rates shall be increased by the same proportion and on the same date as the appropriate Staff Grade Rate Cap adjustment.

Z130.2 The Prices are adjusted for the outstanding portion of the Prices for the amendment to rates in Z130.1.


