TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The contractor will:

- 1. Inspect the site and satisfy themselves as to the suitability for the works quoted.
- 2. Be responsible for removing as necessary any below ground obstructions found (excluding statutory services) to a maximum of 500 mm x 500 mm deep to complete the works.
- 3. Be completely self-sufficient in completing the works, i.e. (but not limited to):
 - I. Provide welfare facilities on site as required.
 - II. Provide secure storage on site.
 - III. Provide and maintain health and safety fencing.
- 4. Keep the site clean and tidy during the works and before leaving at the end of each working day.
- 5. At all times behave responsibly and be mindful of the residential area surrounding the working area.
- 6. Working hours are 8.00 to 18.00 Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays). Working outside of these times is strictly by written prior agreement only.
- 7. Assure the Buyer in writing, that it has the necessary health and safety policies and procedures in place before commencing the works.
- 8. Supply the Buyer with evidence that it has all the necessary insurances (including public liability and professional indemnity) in place before commencing the works.
- 9. Will identify the location of all play equipment on the field for inspection and approval by the Buyer prior to any installation works commencing.
- 10. The Seller will advise of current lead-in times.

Payment:

1. A 5% retention or bond will be required for 12 months commencing from acceptance of the completed works by the Buyer.

Completion of the Works:

- 1. The Seller will present the Buyer the completed works for inspection and acceptance. Any snags noted will be rectified within 14 days.
- 2. The Seller will provide guarantees/warranties for all work and equipment.
- 3. The Buyer will pay valid undisputed invoices within 30 days of completion of the works.
