<p>Technical Activity: Perform HF/HCI Assessment of UI and Undertake Trials that represent the operational context. Report Findings and Recommendations</p> <p>The team would need to comprise of HF SQEP with strengths in HCI design, Def Stan00-251, UX, Operability Analysis, Mil SMEs; the response would need to reflect thinking in terms of the approach to analysis so we'd expect to see UI inspections, walk-talk throughs, reliability assessments (error and task accuracy, SA meausres). The assessment will combine the HF Science with the Operational/End User viewpoint: OK the description is:</p> <p>The objective of the Land C2 Spearhead is to enhance the tactical C2 capability through innovation that integrates automation, artificial intelligence and machine learning technology into the hands of C2 practitioners or user. To that end the EC2SPHD programme has developed a 'Microworld'. This is a conceptual framework which brings together data (i.e. all data that is pertinent to C2), architectures and algorithms for any defined area of operation or geographical region on earth. The EC2SPHD programme has recently instantiated the Microworld to produce a useable Operational Concept Demonstrator (OCD) for a region of the world in support of Exercise Spring Storm as part of UK's contribution to NATO's enhanced Forward Presence (eFP). The OCD allows the user to interact with it through a Human Computer Interface which then provides</p>			

insights/recommendations/etc. to the user in the context of military C2 functions being carried out. To date, the Microworld development has not benefited from a structured Human Factors analysis. The Microworld design process has incorporated some limited C2 SME feedback to date but going forward the work needs to take a more structured approach to Human Factors.

In order to validate the Microworld UI Human Factors assessment activities are required to assess the UI design for compliance to human factors Defence Standards (DStan 00-251) within the operational context using personnel that reflect the target audience from division to sub-unit command posts (CP) then down to dismounted commanders if appropriate.

At this point it is believed that this work does not need to go through MODEC. If MODREC is required the timelines would be extended.
