There is no restriction on a number of people per organisation who can attend this site visit; however the bidders are highly encouraged to bring sensible number of attendees to include their operational as well as management staff on the day.

On the day, Questions and Answers (Q&A) will only be permitted on the building and environment related subjects. An opportunity will be provided to all bidders for asking the service or procurement specific questions during the clarification stage, once the tender has been published.

Last minute changes of attendee names will not be accepted.

Visitors must abide by the "Controlled Articles" protocol. Banned items include though are not limited to electrical devices including mobile phones, laptops, any metal objects, medication and chewing gum.

The prison gate has lockers for the safe storage of personal items/valuables.

Visitors must have photo ID; passport or driving license.
