1 INTEROPERABILITY

The Tenderer shall provide test evidence demonstrating that the 12.7mm API ammunition nature functions in Weapon System A by firing 40 rounds fed from the service magazine. No more than 1 stoppage shall occur for the ammunition nature tested, during this demonstration; the stoppage shall be capable of being cleared by the firer and the firer shall be able to continue to fire the Weapon System. The Tenderer shall fire the chosen quantity of rounds in the Weapon System consecutively and without adjusting the Weapon System configuration specified in this test. The only permitted adjustment to the Weapon System configuration during this test shall be the removal and fitting of the magazine and functioning of working parts.

Evidence shall be provided as range test reports, including continuous videos per serial and photographic evidence. The Tenderer shall provide evidence within the test report of the environmental conditions under which these tests were conducted. At minimum, this information shall provide evidence of the atmospheric pressure and temperature at which these tests are undertaken.

The Tender will receive a mark of PASS or FAIL. If a FAIL is received, the Tender will be discounted from the competition and will no longer be evaluated.
