Terms of Reference

Procurement of goods for Save the Children in respect of humanitarian programmes in Syria

COMPONENT CODE - 204540-104

1. Introduction

Syria is not one of the standard DFID priority countries covered by this framework agreement, and previously, all work involving Syria was handled directly by DFID and NGOs contracted to provide humanitarian assistance on behalf of DFID. However, as noted above, DFID recently decided to temporarily prohibit the NGOs operating under DFID's umbrella from undertaking procurement activities and requested that AECOM procure and deliver items to the NGOs so that they can provide critical humanitarian assistance to Syria.

2. Objective

The non-Syrian NGOs under contract with DFID are operating relief programmes on behalf of the UK government and are providing a wide-range of humanitarian goods and services, including settling refugees in camps and providing temporary accommodations, such as shelters, blankets, food, and other basic comfort items; providing education to children unable to attend a normal school program, along with school supplies (e.g., books, bags, stationery); offering "new mother kits" and newborn items to mothers who have recently given birth; and providing basic emergency medicine and pain relief to those injured in conflict or during travel.

3. Recipient

The primary recipients are the NGOs delivering humanitarian programmes on behalf of DFID in Syria, with the end recipients being those individuals receiving support from the NGOs.

AECOM shall liaise with the recipient with regards to the delivery of the Goods, specifically in relation to the address to where the Goods should be delivered to and how and by whom inspection of Goods will be undertaken.

4. Scope of work

AECOM's role under Framework Agreement will include having an oversight of the procurement planning, sourcing, tendering, technical and commercial evaluation, contract placement, expediting, quality assurance and inspection, progress and financial reporting, reviewing payment and invoicing.

AECOM will provide goods to the required specifications as detailed in Appendix B.

AECOM will be required to liaise directly with the Save the Children and DFID throughout the project.

5. Outputs / Deliverables

AECOM will:

- Undertake all sourcing as per the terms and conditions of their framework agreement with DFID.
- Ensure that procurement of the goods is carried out in line with the project timelines and aims of the project by liaising with the contact.
- Manage the supply base in relation to quality, cost and delivery time and supply contracts.
- Provide a procurement plan with key milestones and progress reports upon achievement of these milestones. These reports shall be submitted to the DFID Programme Officer as detailed in Annex G, and a copy will also be provided to a nominated person at Save the Children.
- Ensure the equipment is delivered to the requested delivery point:

6. Method

In accordance with the Framework Agreement PO 7387, response times for key procurement activities against which the Supplier's performance shall be measured as detailed in Annex E.

Timing and procurement planning are critical to the successful implementation of the Project. AECOM will be expected to demonstrate efficiency, effectiveness, accountability and transparency, and measure and record its associated value added.

AECOM will provide services in line with the Procurement Plan as detailed in Appendix C.

7. Coordination

Clear communication channels and/or approval processes will be established between AECOM, DFID and the Recipient. A communication matrix is attached on Annex G.

8. Reporting

AECOM will submit a final report to DFID Programme officer as detailed in Annex G, providing details of deliverables achieved during the procurement period. This would also include a breakdown of costs for goods, logistics, insurance (if any) and procurement fee to DFID in a format as detailed in Appendix F.

The report will be submitted to the DFID Programme officer and a copy will be provided to the contact person at Save the Children.

9. Timeframe

AECOM will be contracted for the period commencing 29th August 2016 to 21th November 2016. Timing and procurement planning are critical to the successful implementation of the Project. AECOM will be expected to demonstrate efficiency, effectiveness, accountability and transparency, and measure and record its associated value added.

10. Duty of Care (DoC)

AECOM are responsible for the safety and well-being of their personnel (as defined in the Framework Agreement) including third parties affected by their activities under this Call-down Contract, and appropriate security arrangements. They will also be responsible for the provision of suitable security arrangements for their domestic and business property.

AECOM is responsible for ensuring appropriate safety and security briefings for all their personnel working under the Call-down Contract and ensuring that their personnel register and receive appropriate briefing. Travel advice is also available on the FCO website and the supplier must ensure they (and their personnel) are up to date with the latest position.

AECOM is fully responsible for Duty of Care in line with the details provided above and the initial risk assessment matrix developed by DFID as detailed in Annex H. AECOM confirms that:

- They fully accept responsibility for Security and Duty of Care.
- They understand the potential risks and have the knowledge and experience to develop an effective risk plan.
- They have the capability to manage their Duty of Care responsibilities throughout the life of the contract.

11. Payment

Payment will be made on a milestone basis. AECOM will retrospectively invoice for goods as follows:

Milestone Payments

Payment will be made on satisfactory performance of the services, at the payment points defined below:

(i) monthly throughout the contract period.

At each payment point milestones will be defined as part of the schedule of payments. Payment will be made if the criteria are met to the satisfaction of DFID.

Schedule of Payments: Invoices will be generated monthly and paid on the following Milestones;

- Landed goods delivered to final destination in month, inclusive of associated costs of quality control activities.
