This notice is not a call for competition - The Coal Authority intends to issue the call for competition on or after 12<sup>th</sup> April 2019

The Coal Authority was established by Parliament to undertake specific statutory duties, set out in the Coal Industry Act 1994, associated with licensing coal mining operations; managing property and the historic legacy arising from the ownership of the coal reserves and underground workings; settling subsidence damage claims not falling on coal mine operators and providing access to coal mining information.

Deliverables from this requirement will be to replace 3 No. 2mm HDPE lagoon liners totalling approximately 15,000m<sup>2</sup>, construct a flow meter chamber and undertake minor metalwork safety works at Woodside Mine Water Treatment Scheme . The liners will be free issued to the successful contractor.

The location of this site known as Woodside MWTS is located in Shipley Country Park, nr Ilkeston, Nottinghamshire. (444991, 343126).
