(1.4) Term of Contract:

The Call-off Order shall commence on 01/02/2022 for a period of fourteen (14) months, expiring on 31/03/2023.

(1.5) Term extension options:

The Customer may extend the term of the Contract by up to twelve (12) months, until 31/03/2024 ("Extension"). The terms of the Contract shall apply throughout the period of the Extension.
