Thank you for expressing an interest in working with Highways England.

The TST supply route is a two-stage process. Firstly, you are required to register as a TST Supplier which consists of completing a registration questionnaire. I attach a zipped folder with the relevant documents and recommend you read the document entitled 'Supplier Briefing pack v6.docx' in the first instance. This process covers a range of disciplines and you can apply to be registered for as many as you wish. If you do decide to register, please submit your completed registration documents to: <a href="mailto:nationaltst@highwaysengland.co.uk">nationaltst@highwaysengland.co.uk</a>. Please note that there is no deadline for the submission of the documents and the assessment of your registration can take several weeks.

Once you have passed the registration process, you will be invited to Tender for the survey work in the areas that you have indicated you can supply. The Tender process is conducted electronically, (currently via the BRAVO system - see further details on this below). Ordinarily we award the survey work to the lowest priced compliant Tender.

To confirm, this route to market only applies to those areas, currently 1 & 2, 6 & 8, 7, 10, 13 & 14, which have adopted the new 'Asset Led' delivery model at Highways England. However, the intention is that the TST procurement route will eventually be rolled out across all areas as they move to the new delivery model. Please note that it excludes major projects.



The second part of the process is to ensure you are registered on Highways England's e-sourcing portal BRAVO. Only after successful registration on BRAVO (https://highways.bravosolution.co.uk), will you be able to tender for work or view portal information. Once you have completed and passed the registration process, you will be eligible to be invited to tender for works that you have indicated you can provide.
