Proporsal

- 1) Seperate Pricing for each LOT
  - 2) LOT 1 - Providers to submit an indicitive maximum hourly rate. The idicitive price rate for LOT1 will not be evaluated as part of the tender process to establish the DPS List, these indicative prices will be used as guide pricing and set ceiling price when evaluating tenders or quotations during the mini competition process run by the Council between the suppliers on the on the DPS list.
    - a. LBE suggests a basic minimum rate of £14.00 this takes into account rise in in the Living Wage in 2016-17 and support staff recruitment and retention.
  - 3) LOT 2 – We ask you at tender stage to submit an indicative hourly rate for LOT2 but as the need varies prices will be agreed at call off at the mini competition process.
- Costs must be all inclusive, including training, management overheads and travel time to jobs but should not include any costs incurred for community-based activities.
  - Submissions must be realistic and supported by a credible approach to achieving the service outcome
