

St Briavels Parish Council – Grass cutting contract – Areas to be cut – Appendix A

Grassed area classification definition:

Amenity - identified by number. These are areas cut for the amenity of the village, to help keep the village neat and tidy for the benefit of residents and visitors. Arisings are to be evenly distributed over those areas (left to lie) and not left in mounds

Border / Churchyard - identified by number, with the prefix 'BC'. Whilst also being technically 'amenity' areas, these are areas where the arisings must be collected and removed. Borders delineate wildflower areas and ensure safe roadside visibility. The Churchyard requires particular neatness and extra care.

Wildflower - identified by number with the prefix 'W'. These are the "Wildflower Project" areas - see section 8. Its important arisings are to be collected and removed, to reduce soil fertility.
