

## **Appendix 1 – Community Consultation Outcomes**

The design elements that were identified from the consultation are as below:

- The design should appeal to all riding disciplines and age groups, and features should be included which will cater for both novice riders as well as experienced riders.
- The skatepark should be designed to be an inclusive and accessible space for all.
- The surface of the skatepark must be finished so that it is smooth and fast, and retain adequate grip for skateboarders, BMX riders and scooters.
- The facility must be designed to make best use of the location and sit sensitively within the landscape, featuring planting.
- The facility should be designed as a community space and provide seating, litter bins and signage.
- The facility must be designed within the latest European safety guidelines and a RoSPA post installation report will be required on completion

In no particular order of importance, the design must include the following features,

- Quarter pipes in variety of differing heights
- Mini ramp Section/s
- Rollovers to generate speed
- Bowled out element/s
- Extensions
- Hips to redirect flowlines
- Rolling section
- Rails and Ledges
- Stairset
- Flatbank sections
- Spine Section
- Open Areas
- There should be an emphasis on flow throughout the design
