

GLAP owned land at Beam Reach 5 adjacent to the HS1 railway line and that it is to be removed as a matter of urgency. As GLAP is under threat of legal action and could be liable for any damage or injury resulting from the fly tipped material, this material must be removed immediately and it is recommended that Seneca Environmental Solutions Limited who is working on another GLAP contract removing fly tipped material from Bean Park is contracted to remove this material at an estimated cost of £97164.53.


