EMERGENT WORK

1. The labour price element of an emergent work task undertaken by the Contractor in accordance with Clause 4.12 (Emergent Work) shall be priced using the relevant labour rate (for resource type and calendar year) from the table shown below:

2. Emergent work tasks in excess of 15 labour hours are subject to pre-authorisation by the Authority in accordance with Annex Q Appendix 2. Such pre-authorisation shall be obtained via the Contractor submitting a completed task authorisation in the form of the document at Appendix 2 Annex Q and receiving written authorisation from the Authority to proceed.
3. The Contractor shall provide the Authority with evidence of the cost of the material content. Information such as copies of sub-contractor invoices, or screen shots of the Contractors cost recording system, or such further information as the Authority may reasonably require shall be acceptable evidence.
4. The Labour and Material prices shall be recorded in the monthly cost statement to be provided by the Contractor under Clause 4.12.
5. The Contractor may claim payment for emergent work on a quarterly basis, in March, June, September and December of each year, or such greater frequency at the Contractors discretion. Payment shall be made using the CP&F system in accordance with Clause 9.1.
