1	Do you have an idea of approximately how many clients the pilots, singly or collectively, the projects intend to work with over the pilot period? We recognise that the projects are currently developing their plans, but a broad idea would be helpful in addressing your questions.	Provisionally, across the 3 Regions, we expect 300 clients to be engaged in year 1, an additional 300 clients to be engaged in year 2 and an additional 500 to be engaged in year 3. This is subject to change as the Pilots develop their plans.	22.03.2018
2	What are your expectations in terms of who would collect individual baseline and follow-up/outcome data – would this be the projects' responsibility or the evaluators? Data collection expectations will be particularly important in terms of your question on costs per interview as these will be dependent on scale and mode, i.e. are these costs intended to be for in-depth qualitative interviews (undertaken with a sample of clients) or for follow-up more quantitative interviews to collect outcome data across a larger share/all of the participants?	We are expecting the collection of baseline and follow-up/outcome data to be the responsibility of the evaluators. We are looking to understand the costs associated with interviews undertaken with all clients that are part of the impact evaluation.	22.03.2018
3	Do you expect the reporting of the impact evaluation to be for the pilots overall (i.e. an aggregate of all three areas) or individually?	We are expecting the reporting of the impact evaluation to be for the pilots overall, on an aggregate basis.	22.03.2018
4	Do you have information on roll-out plans locally? – this will help inform our thinking on potential comparator areas and associated cost implications, i.e. whether comparison groups could be constructed within each region, or whether we would be looking to other areas?	Draft Implementation plans will be shared when the tender is launched. Provisionally, we expect 300 clients to be engaged in year 1 across all three Regions, an additional 300 to be engaged in year 2 and an additional 500 to be engaged in year 3. Consideration of the appropriate comparison group will be a key focus of the scoping phase.	22.03.2018
