

**CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF INDUSTRIAL HYDROGEN
ACCELERATOR STREAM 2A TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR BUSINESS,
ENERGY AND INDUSTRIAL STRATEGY**

This Contract is dated September 13th, 2022 and is made between:-

1. **The Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy** [“the Authority”] of 1 Victoria Street, London SW1H 0ET, acting as part of the Crown;

and
2. **ASH Waste Services Ltd** (the “Contractor”) whose registered office is at ASH Waste Services, The Mill, Moreton, Oswestry, Shropshire, SY10 8BH.

INTRODUCTION

- (A) On 28 April 2022 the Authority issued an invitation to tender for the provision of Industrial Hydrogen Accelerator (IHA) Stream 2A this including the specification a copy of which is set out in Schedule 1 (the “Specification”).
- (B) In response the Contractor submitted a proposal dated 23 June 2022 and entitled **Small-scale hydrogen production utilising a waste company's SRF feedstock to power its industrial plant and equipment** explaining how it would provide the services a copy of which is set out in Schedule 2 (the “Proposal”).
- (C) The Specification and the Proposal were supplemented by the correspondence copies of which are set out in Schedule 5 (the “Correspondence”).

The parties agree as follows:-

1. SUPPLY OF SERVICES AND PRICE

In consideration of payment by the Authority to the Contractor of the sum of £175,844.02 (exclusive of Value Added Tax) (the “Contract Price”) and in accordance with (a) **Schedule 1** - the Specification ; (b) **Schedule 2** - the Proposal; and (c) **Schedule 3** - the Authority's Standard Terms and Conditions of Contract for Supplies/Services (the “Standard Terms” (a copy of which were issued by the Authority with the Invitation to Tender and are attached at Schedule 3); (d) **Schedule**

4 - the Project Plan and Finance Table (e) **Schedule 5** - the Correspondence; the Contractor shall provide the Services described in the Specification, the Proposal, the Project Finance Table and the Correspondence to the Authority.

2. COMMENCEMENT AND CONTINUATION

This contract shall commence on Sept 13th and subject to any provisions for earlier termination contained in the Standard Terms end on **31 March 2023**.

3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 3.1 The Standard Terms shall form part of this Contract.
- 3.2 The Contractor's Standard Terms and Conditions of business shall not apply to this Contract.
- 3.3 This Contract is formed of these clauses and the Schedules hereto. Any other attachments are provided for information purposes only and are not intended to be legally binding. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency, the documents prevail in the following order:
 - a) these clauses;
 - b) the Standard Terms (as set out in Schedule 3);
 - c) the Correspondence (as set out in Schedule 5);
 - d) the Specification (as set out in Schedule 1) and Contract Price (as set out in Schedule 4);
 - e) the Project Plan and Finance Table (as set out in Schedule 4)
 - f) finally, the Contractor's Proposal (as set out in Schedule 2)

4. CONTRACTOR'S OBLIGATIONS

- 4.1 Where the Contractor is supplying goods to the Authority these shall be delivered to the Authority in full compliance with the Specification and shall be of satisfactory quality and fit for purpose. Where the Contractor is performing services for the Authority it shall do so in accordance with the Specification and exercise reasonable skill and care.

5. MANAGEMENT AND COMMUNICATIONS

- 5.1 The Contractor shall perform the Services under the direction of the Authority.
- 5.2 Any direction by the Authority may be given by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who is an officer in the Authority's Science and Innovation for Climate and Energy Directorate, 1 Victoria Street London SW1H 0ET, [REDACTED] or such other person as is notified by the Authority to the Contractor in writing.

- 5.3 The Contractor appoints [REDACTED]

Flintshire, LL13 9AE to be the Contractor's first point of contact for this
Contract. All queries to the Contractor from the Authority's Contract
Manager shall initially be addressed to the Contractor's first point of
contact.
- 5.4 The Contractor's first point of contact and the Contract Manager shall
meet as often as either the Contractor or the Authority may require to
review the Contractor's performance of the Contract.

6. INVOICES AND PAYMENT

- 6.1 Subject to the Contractor providing the Services to the Authority in
accordance with this Contract and submitting invoice/s to the Contract
Manager in the manner reasonably required by the Contract Manager,
payment will be made by the Authority to the Contractor in accordance
with condition 11 of the Standard Terms.

7. TRANSPARENCY

- 7.1 The Authority will publish the Contract and the Schedules hereto on a
designated government internet site, using a redacted version of the
contract in line with the exemptions under the Freedom of Information
Act 2000 (FOIA) and Condition 41 of the Standard Terms.

However, subject to those redactions, the rest of the Contract and
Schedules will be published in full, in accordance with the
government's policy on the publication of contracts, which forms
part of the government's transparency agenda, and the Contract
is therefore entered into on the basis of such publication taking place.

The Authority emphasises that its decision to redact information
on this occasion does not preclude it publishing such information
in the future in the context of other contracts. Neither does it
preclude the disclosure of such information in the circumstances
of a request for disclosure under FOIA or the Environmental
Information Regulations 2004 (EIR) or where such disclosure is
required by virtue of any other legal requirement. In such cases,
the Authority would need to consider disclosure in the context of
the particular circumstances of the request or requirement
concerned.
