## Scale Up 4 Growth Gloucestershire (S4GG) Summative Assessment

## Introduction

The University of the West of England, Bristol, runs several European Regional Development Funded (ERDF) projects. Each of these projects has an evaluation requirement known as Summative Assessment (SA).

We are looking for an external consultant to undertake the SA on our Scale Up 4 Growth Gloucestershire programme. S4GG started on 1 January 2021 and SME activity ends on 31 December 2022. The budget for this work is approximately  $\pounds$ 18,000 inc. VAT.

S4GG has 2 streams of activity, aiming to support 71 SMEs:

- Business support grant funding, with grants between £10k and £40k for SMEs in Gloucestershire to help their business grow (approximately 35 to be awarded)
- Business growth and cyber security workshops (up to 6 workshops with at least 36 participants)

- 3. Value for money
- 4. Environmental sustainability
