Delivery of WAN Link for UK Debt Management Office (DMO)

SCOPE OF TENDER

To deliver a high bandwidth, low latency, fibre channel WAN link between the DMO's two datacentres. Installation, rental costs and support arrangements must be included within the tender response.

BACKGROUND

The DMO is an Executive Agency of Her Majesty's Treasury. The DMO's responsibilities include debt and cash management for the UK Government, lending to local authorities and managing certain public sector funds.

Currently the DMO occupies offices in the City of London, with the primary data centre located at **REDACTED**. A secondary data centre provides Disaster Recovery (DR) capability and is provided at **REDACTED**.

The DMO is undertaking a programme of work to improve its systems resilience, the objective of which is to reduce the impact of any IT infrastructure failure scenarios on its end users by:

- Ensuring the automated recovery of its systems.
- Moving from a primary and DR configuration of its data centres to one stretched logical datacentre across both locations.
- Implementing EMC VPLEX Metro and VMWare High Availability to achieve this
- Delivering the capacity to enable the operation of Fault Tolerance on a small number of VM's delivering time critical business processes.

The investigation and analysis conducted by the DMO has recommended the implementation of a solution using EMC VPLEX Metro. DMO has worked with EMC on an exercise to demonstrate the detailed workings of this product to confirm its suitability. This exercise identified that this solution requires a fibre channel WAN link to connect the DMO's data centres. Furthermore EMC has performed an analysis of DMO's SAN I/O statistics and layout information to determine the specification of this link.
